SCHOOL ATTENDANCE ASSISTANCE "Shugaku-enjo"

You need to apply
for "Shugaku-enjo"
every year!



School attendance assistance "Shugaku-enjo" is a system that assists those who have difficulties paying for school lunches, school supplies, and other expenses necessary for school life due to financial reasons. If you would like to receive a scholarship, please apply.

Eligible Households

You must be a resident of Kurume City (*), a parent or guardian of a child attending a national or public elementary and/or junior high school, and a household that falls under any of the following (private schools are not eligible).

※Those who are receiving public assistance cannot apply.

※Some of the expenses will be paid even if you reside outside of Kurume as long as your child attends schools described within the city.

- (1) Public assistance has been suspended or abolished (abolished after April 1, 2025)
- (2) Receiving full child support allowance
- (3) All members of the household are exempt from paying all national pension insurance premiums
- (4) All household members are exempted from Municipal Residents Tax
- (5) The living condition deteriorated rapidly due to special circumstances such as the death of a guardian, separation, or unemployment
- (6) Although (1)-(5) do not apply, the income of all household members is low, and life is very difficult

※About 630,000 yen will be added for each additional person in a household of more than 7 people.

The examination will be based on the combined income of all members of the same household.

However, you maybe eligible for assistance even if this amount is exceeded

Assistance will be determined by the screening depending on every households situation. Please apply first.

What You Need to Apply

□ Applicant's (Parents/Guardian's) Personal Financial Statement or Report (such as a bankbook)

If any of the following applies, please bring the necessary documents:

- Households with Disability Certificate holders:
 - Disability Certificate (physical, medical rehabilitation and/or mental disability)
 - All household members are exempted from the National Pension Premium:
 - Approval Letter for National Pension Exemption for all your household members over 20 years old
 - ※ Please bring the postcard issued by the National Pension Service.
 - Sudden change in living conditions due to certain circumstances such as death, marital separation or unemployment of parents:
 - Document to verify current status, such as Certificate of Unemployment or Notification of Absence from your employer / work place
 - If you reside outside of Kurume (but your child is enrolled in a public school in Kurume):
 - Resident Card for all household members
 - Income Tax Declaration Certificate for all household members over 16 years old issued at the Municipal Office in the city you lived in as of January 1, 2025
 - If you moved to Kurume after January 2, 2025:
 - Income Tax Declaration Certificate for all household members over 16 years old issued at the Municipal Office in the city you lived in as of January 1, 2025
